

# BMB BoD Meeting Minutes

July 2, 2025 / 7:00 PM

## Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:06 PM.

## Minutes of Last Meeting

Board members reviewed the minutes of the June 12 meeting and approved the minutes as submitted (motion: **Dawnel**; second: **Ron**).

## Monthly Reports

### President

**Chris** reported that a final payment for the current use permit had been submitted.

**Chris** detailed his meeting with **Richard** from Santa Clara County Parks. **Chris** added that **Richard** had expressed support for BMB obtaining a lease. He had suggested the club obtain a business license from the city; **Chris** said he would contact the city to see what needs to be done. **Tam** said that it was basically filling out a form and paying applicable fees; however, the business license is tied to the “business’s” ownership structure, so we should look into incorporating as a nonprofit first.

**Chris** said he had discussed the upcoming Taste Of Archery event, and that the County was interested in holding more in the future if it goes well.

Board members discussed general maintenance items at Santa Teresa County Park; **Chris** said he would talk with County Parks to clarify what the club is responsible for and what SCC Parks should handle.

### Treasurer

**Ron** reported the current account balances: [REDACTED] in Wells-Fargo, and [REDACTED] in PayPal. He presented the current balance sheet and noted that 3D League revenues are about half of what they were last year. He noted some food and Predators expenses for which he still needed

invoices. He reported \$500 had been spent on medals for 3D League and other events; he added that he had placed these materials for the 3D League BBQ in the trailer.

**Dawnel** asked about the U-Haul expenses; **Ron** explained that these were U-Haul rentals for the 3D League, and also for moving newly purchased target rounds from Predators. **Dawnel** suggested doing a full accounting of 3D League expenses and revenue, and **Ron** said he would do so.

A motion by **Ron** (second: **Tam**) to spend up to \$500 on raffle prizes for the 3D League BBQ was passed unanimously. **Chris** said he or **Ron** would pick up the prizes from Predators.

## Secretary

**Chris** asked how many BMB members are registered for 2025; **Tam** replied about 114 plus some lifetime members. **Ron** noted that 5 members had joined or renewed in the past month; **Tam** added that the current total was close to the final numbers for 2024. **Tam** added that he would like to get SJSU archers added to the roster, to keep them informed of Club events and to encourage them to participate as Club members.

**Tam** said that the Club's website could use some sprucing up; he would discuss with **Mark** about what tools might be available to do this with less effort.

**Tam** announced that he had created a mailing list (Google group) called "bmb-announce" to send news and announcements to members, that is also open to non-members.

## SJSU Updates

**Thalia** said that she had no new updates as SJSU is not currently in session. She said she would get an SJSU Archery roster for **Tam** once the semester gets under way.

**Thalia** said that SJSU Archery was interested in holding another CAT shoot event this fall.

## Old Business

### Work Party

**Tam** said the upcoming Work Party would prioritize replacing bales on targets, as he did not like the PacBow bales sitting out in the open for too long. He added that in the last monthly mailing he had told people they could work with him to replace bales at times other than the Work Party if they could supply a truck and a couple pairs of hands.

**Tam** suggested adopting a more flexible work schedule so people can help out at more convenient times, as not all tasks need to be done during the Work Party.

### BMB Jerseys

**Mark** reported that YoungSpeeds has apparently rebranded and is now called GoatNewBee (GNB).

**Mark** said that five jerseys had been ordered via the ordering link so far. He added that we should let members know they need to order ASAP to receive their jerseys in time for August tournaments.

Mark remarked that it was nice to see BMB jerseys at the State Outdoors (SAC) event.

### **Security**

Chris said he would talk with the County Parks to see if they have any suggestions with regards to getting the container doors repaired. Tam said that he thought Chris had a contractor lined up to make the repairs; Chris said that he didn't show up.

### **3D League BBQ/Potluck**

Tam said he would get supplies for the event from Costco this weekend.

Board members discussed the 3D League awards and looked over the list of medalists. Ron asked if we had told everyone they needed 10 scores to qualify; Tam confirmed that it's stated plainly on the 3D League information and rules web page.

Board members discussed the raffle and the logistics of gathering prizes for it.

### **Taste of Archery**

Chris said he had confirmed with Carrie Grisenti from County Parks that the event will take place on July 26. Tam asked if there was a web page for the event; Chris replied there was. Board members reviewed the web page and found that the range address/location information needs to be corrected.

Tam asked if he needed to send out a call for volunteers; Chris said that he should be able to staff the events with volunteers from SJSU. Tam and Ron added that they would be happy to help with the event.

### **Tractor repairs**

Tam said that he had not talked with Harold about a tractor mechanic.

### **Termite treatment for tool shed**

Tam said that Shawn DeLong had said he would email the club an estimate for the termite treatment, but had not done so yet.

### **Coyote 600**

Chris said that he had not yet reached out to SF Archers about whether or not they plan to hold it again, but that he would do so tonight.

### **Golden Arrow tournament**

Chris said he had reached out to Karen Keating about how past events were run, but had not heard back yet.

### **SAC tournament debrief**

**Dawnel** reported that this was the biggest tournament that State Archers of California (SAC) had ever hosted. She said that the event could have benefited from more volunteers helping out, particularly with setup and teardown.

**Chris** said that he had heard positive comments almost universally, so hopefully we can do this again next year and do it better.
