

# BMB BoD Meeting Minutes

January 7, 2026 / 7:00 PM

## Attendees

## Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM.

## Minutes of Last Meeting

Board members reviewed the minutes of the December 3 meeting and approved the minutes as submitted (motion: **Tam**; second: **Mark**).

## Monthly Reports

### President

Chris reported that he had sent emails to the County about previously-discussed safety issues, and servicing of the upper lot porta potty; he had not yet received a response. He had also been in talks with head ranger **Colby**, who will meet with him soon to provide some warning signs to put up to improve safety by preventing stray hikers from wandering into the archery range.

Chris said that he was waiting on filed permits to be approved.

Chris said he had been trying to recruit a Range Captain and find volunteers for other missing roles.

### Treasurer

Board members reviewed the latest updates to the club financial report that **Ron** had shared, and went over the projected 2026 budget.

**Tam** made a note to ask **Ron** if the 3D target inserts were in the budget, and to check if the payment had been sent to **Little Sioux** for the target bales.

### Secretary

**Tam** reported that there had been 23 renewals for 2026 so far, which was quite good considering it was still the first week of the year.

### SJSU Updates

**Thalia** said that **Brandon** had spoken with **Chris** about repairing target stands ahead of the WINTRR tournament. She added that they were waiting to hear back from **Ron** about arranging for extra porta potties for the event; **Chris** said he had spoken with **Ron** on this matter.

**Thalia** asked if there was any plan for a rescheduled work party this month. **Tam** said that there was not, due to uncertainty with the weather and a number of competing events happening that weekend; he added he would be happy to help out as needed.

**Chris** said that he had noticed some potholes in the upper lot that should be filled, lest they fill with water if it rains during the event.

**Tam** asked if the stacks of new straw bales would interfere with the event; **Chris** affirmed that at the very least, the larger stack of bales would need to be moved. **Tam** suggested getting some kind of wagon or cart to make it easier to move the bales.

**Tam** reminded **Thalia** that he had intended to work with her to get a list of SJSU archers last year to get them officially in the BMB membership roster, but that they had not managed to follow through. **Thalia** acknowledged that this had slipped through the cracks due to a number of organizational changes on the SJSU side, but reaffirmed that they would try to get this done this year. **Chris** noted that he also needed to finish formalizing the contract between BMB and SJSU.

## Old Business

### Work Party

**Tam** said that the work party had been cancelled due to the weather.

### BMB Jerseys

**Chris** said that a few jerseys had not yet been picked up; he would see about getting them to those who ordered them.

**Tam** noted that the GNB ordering page for the jerseys had gone down, but was presently working again.

### Tractor repairs

**Chris** said that he had not recently seen **James**, who had previously offered to look into getting the tractor up and running again. He added that he had talked with **Harold** who had suggested it might be worth it to buy a new (used) tractor that would be a bit more reliable; **Tam** said that this might be worthwhile, as it would make handling the new bales a lot easier.

### Tool Shed Termite Treatment

**Chris** said he would contact **Shawn DeLong** about having the tool shed treated this year.

### Coyote 600

**Chris** said he had no updates to share.

## Golden Arrow tournament

Chris said he was still working on a proposal and hoped to have it ready for the next meeting.

## Target bales

Board members reviewed **Chuck's** report about the current state of the target bales.

**Tam** said he would see to it that rain covers would be put on targets that had lost them, next Work Party.

## Upper lot trailer repairs

**Chris** reported that the blue container's door had started to shift a bit, making it difficult to close and lock, and said he would continue monitoring to see if repairs might be needed.

**Chris** said that the previous week he had found the container with the mower unlocked and a set of keys left inside. He said he had contacted **Mark W.** about it but had not received a response.

## New Business

### 2026 Schedule

Board members looked at what events needed to be scheduled for BMB this year:

- MTBA Outdoor Regional, in mid-August.
- CBH State Outdoor, mid-September.
  - **Chris** said we usually use the weekend that the Club Shoot would normally be held, i.e. the second Sunday of the month.
  - **Mark** noted that the SAC Pac Coast tournament is Sept. 19-20.
- Golden Arrow?
  - **Chris** said that it used to be held in July.
- USAT-style event?
  - **Tam** noted that even if we made it a two-day event, the size of the event would be limited by the available space.
  - **Chris** said some weekend in May or June would be best.

**Chris** said he had a meeting scheduled with the heads of other MTBA clubs on the 18th so he would resolve the date of the MTBA Regional by then.

**Tam** said he had reached out to **Tere** who had been helpful with scheduling in the past.

### 3D League

**Tam** asked what changes we wanted to make to this year's 3D League, to hopefully improve participation. He said he would work on sending out a survey to previous years' participants to see what changes they might want.

### Shed Painting

**Chris** reported that much of the leftover old paint that was used to paint the sheds is no longer in usable condition, so we'll need to purchase new paint. **Tam** added that the old paint should be disposed of properly.

**Chris** said he had spoken with the County regarding painting and said they had given the okay to paint the sheds as we see fit.
