

BMB BoD Meeting Minutes

March 4, 2026 / 7:00 PM

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM.

Minutes of Last Meeting

Board members reviewed the minutes of the February 4 meeting, made some minor corrections, and approved the minutes as amended (motion: **Ron**; second: **Gregg**).

Monthly Reports

President

Chris reported that he was working on submitting permit applications for the year's events. He added that no permit was needed for 3D League events.

Chris said he was discussing a possible lease agreement with **Linda** at Santa Clara County; they would be meeting up at the range to discuss the site and BMB's contributions to its upkeep and improvement.

Treasurer

Ron reported the current account balances: [REDACTED] in PayPal, [REDACTED] in Wells-Fargo.

Ron presented the past month's financials, saying there had been relatively little activity. Expenses included PayPal expenses and concession fees to the County. **Tam** mentioned that he had a few outstanding receipts for wallpaper paste, and hardware for target frame upgrades.

Chris said that he was working to get **Ron** full access to BMB's Wells-Fargo account.

Secretary

Tam reported that there were 60 membership renewals for 2026 so far.

SJSU Updates

Thalia said she was still finalizing the roster of SJSU archers to send to BMB, and working on the contract with BMB.

Thalia reported that she has been talking with San Jose city parks about potentially holding an archery event in one of the parks.

Chris mentioned that SJSU has gotten permission to set up an outdoor archery range on campus so some of SJSU's targets would be moved to that location.

Old Business

Work Party

Chris said he would contact **Ashkan** about whether they're coming out to coordinate County Parks volunteers. **Ron** said there was still a lot to be done on the Upper 14 trail, including dealing with poison oak, but a lot of progress had been made at the last Work Party.

Tam said he would like to see more targets pasted, as **Moni** had been replacing target faces more frequently and using up the current stocks. He added that he had pasted some targets at home.

Tam mentioned issues with fitting the new target bales on the existing frames, and suggested maybe using metal banding as is done at SF Archers. **Stephen** and **Ron** related their experience with target bales attached this way at SF Archers and Bowhunters Unlimited, saying that the bands aren't as adjustable and don't apply pressure on the bales.

Tractor repairs

Chris said that his brother would be coming to the range during the Work Party or the following week to look at the tractor.

Tool Shed Termite Treatment

Chris said he had received a message from **Shawn DeLong**, and needed to follow up.

Coyote 600

Chris said he had no updates.

Golden Arrow tournament

Chris said he was holding off on proposing a Golden Arrow tournament this year until the Upper 14 is in better shape.

He said that instead, he'd like to do the USAT-style event, in early June.

Upper lot trailer repairs

Ron said he had not yet started on the repairs he had proposed.

3D target inserts

Chris said that **Curtis** had asked him which 3D inserts we needed; **Ron** said he would have a list ready soon.

3D League

Tam presented results from the survey responses he had received from 3D League participants. He said that respondents had narrowly favored simpler divisions, staying with 2 drops. Opinions on the number of scores needed for awards were mixed; after some discussion **Tam** proposed lowering the minimum to 9, noting that with 2 drops anyone with only 9 scores would be greatly disadvantaged.

Board members discussed whether the age range for the Senior category should be changed. **Tam** noted the age range for 3D League already skews older.

Board members discussed entry fees and the fee structure, and decided to keep prices unchanged.

New Business

SJSU/San Jose Parks event

Thalia said she would keep the Board in the loop about any developments.

Club shoot

Tam reviewed details of the upcoming Club Shoot.

Jerseys

Mark said he was putting in a small order of light-colored jerseys. He mentioned that GNB would also be sending him a BMB banner.

Tam said there were still some unclaimed jerseys, and that he would try reaching out to those who ordered them.

New meeting time

Board members discussed a new day for upcoming Board meetings, since Wednesday evening would conflict with 3D League.
