

BMB BoD Meeting Minutes

August 5, 2026 / 7:00 PM

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:07 PM.

Minutes of Last Meeting

Board members reviewed the minutes of the July 1 meeting and approved the minutes as submitted (motion: **Chuck**; second: **Steve**).

Monthly Reports

President

Chris said he had an upcoming meeting with County Parks later this month. He mentioned he would discuss maintenance responsibilities to clarify some unresolved uncertainties.

Chris said that the permit for the MTBA 900 had been approved; he added the State 900 permit was still in progress but should be approved in time.

Chris said he had no updates to report regarding a lease.

Board members discussed the upcoming Taste of Archery event, scheduled for Saturday August 15. **Chris** said the event was sold out, with 75 entrants per session; he said we would need to set up 5-6 targets and a corresponding number of volunteer instructors. **Tam** noted he would be out of town but would put out a call for volunteers.

Treasurer

Ron reported a current total cash balance of [REDACTED], [REDACTED] in Wells-Fargo and [REDACTED] in PayPal. He presented the latest updates to the annual budget and balance sheet for the year to date.

Ron asked if the recurring charge with United (porta potties) had been resolved; **Chris** said that it had not, as they had called while he was away, and he would call them back.

Secretary

Tam said there were now 102 paid members, noting that the final tally this year will probably fall short of last year's 140, and would likely end up more in line with the 120 or so from 2024..

SJSU Updates

Chris said a new representative from SJSU Archery, **Grace Le**, would attend the next meeting. He said the school semester begins on August 19, with the first archery practice scheduled for August 28.

Chris said that SJSU Archery had decided not to hold another Spartan CAT Shoot this year. However, the WINTRR tournament would likely be happening again early next year.

Old Business

Work Party

Tam reported on the past weekend's Work Party. He said there had been 3 volunteers from the County Parks. The lower bale on Target 4 was replaced, and a ratchet strap was used to replace 2 failed bands on the upper bale.

Tam said the Upper 14 trail was now fully cleared. He said someone had cleared it on their own and that he and two of the County volunteers had cleaned up the rest. Other than bales needing replacement, the Upper 14 is now fully open for business.

Tam said other volunteers had cut cardboard and pasted targets. He added that **Dave Petty** had refurbished the tables by target 9.

Santa Teresa Cup

Tam showed a completed trophy for the event, saying that all trophies are finished and now being distributed to event winners.

Chris proposed an earlier date for next year's event, **May 8-9, 2027**. **Tam** said this would be better as things were too busy this past June.

3D League Potluck/BBQ

Tam said the event had gone well overall. He reviewed the Costco receipt he had filed for \$108.46 for food for the BBQ.

Ron said there was a shortage of medals as there were apparently more medalists than he had counted, but he had handed out some buckles as a substitute.

Range Map Near Target 9

Tam showed the 1994 map Ron had found, noting that there have been some changes to the field course since it was drawn up. He said he would scan the map and look into making some edits to update the map to reflect the current course.

Additional Upgrades for 3D Storage

Ron said he had made plans for shelving, adding that we have the necessary plywood and he just needed to get some lumber. He said better storage would allow us to better organize 3D targets and see what's needed and what needs to be repaired.

Long Range Historical Shoot

Steve said he had held a second shoot on July 11, with 6 archers attending. They had set up two targets, one at each end of the shot, so that they wouldn't need to go all the way to the target and back between ends. He said he would like to hold more events.

End-Of-Year Banquet

Chris said he was still looking for a venue for the event.

New Business

MTBA 900 Preparation

Tam said he had already put down the shooting and target lines for the event, so all that was needed was to measure out lanes and stand up targets the evening before the event.

Chris said he would check that we have enough target faces for the event.

August 22 Historical Shoot

Steve said that there had been interest in holding another shoot on August 22, but that he would be away. He asked if someone else could run the event and coordinate with someone who has keys to the upper lot containers. Tam said that as long as it was someone who was familiar with how to run the event and they followed the same procedures, this would be acceptable.

Porta-Potty in Upper Lot

Chris said the porta-potty in the upper lot had not been serviced in many months. He said he had been asking County Parks to get it serviced again or else arrange to have it taken away.
